THE ASSAM LOCAL BOARD ELECTIONS (EMERGENCY PROVISIONS) ACT, 1936.

ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE POST-PONEMENT OF LOCAL BOARD ELEC-TION.

Whereas the triennial elections of Local Boards in Assam are required by the existing law to be held before the 1st April 1937 and whereas it is expedient to postpone the said elections to a later period without thereby disturbing the triennial occurrence of the elections;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Assam Local Board Elections (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1936.

Post pone-

Post pone-ment of elec-tions.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section 9 of the Assam Local Self-Government Act, 1915, the triennial elections in the year Assam Act, 1937 may be postponed by order of Government for any period not more than one year from the 1st April 1937.
